Spectator Waiver & Release Form (Spectator Rules)

1. You must sign a liability waiver and agree to all the spectator regulations of the NIAA and the golf course before being allowed to follow play.
2. You must follow proper educational and golf course etiquette:
 - a. No alcohol or tobacco use at a high school activity.
 - b. No talking or other noise making during a participant's shot.
 - c. No movements or an action during a participant's shot.
 - d. No photography during a participant's shot.
 - e. Keep the golf course clean.
 - f. Don not walk on the tee boxes, fairways, greens, sand traps, etc. (you must stay on the cart paths and/or in rough areas).
3. You must stay 25 yards away from participants during play.
 - a. Any communication with a participant, either verbal or non-verbal, will result in a penalty stroke or the disqualification of the participant.
 - b. No coaching is allowed by spectators.
4. Be courteous to the golf course and its staff. You are their guest.
5. The golf course staff will determine if golf carts are available for spectators.
6. You will be asked to leave the grounds if a rule (listed above or below) is broken.

Non-Player Acknowledgment

I understand that my presence upon the playing areas of the golf course as a spectator or in any other non-playing capacity represents:

1. A use for which the golf course was not intended or designed;
2. A substantial risk to my person, not limited to the obvious danger of being struck by a golf ball;
3. A potential annoyance and distraction to the competitors.

With this in mind, while I am on the golf course:

1. I agree to conduct myself in a quiet, courteous manner and will avoid any interference (including intimidating actions) with players;
2. **I agree to refrain from the use of any and all electronic devices. This includes, but is not limited to, cell phones, iPods, CD players, or measuring devices.**
3. I will be responsible for any damage that I might cause;
4. I will not hold responsible the golf course or any of its employees, agents or managers for damage or injury I might sustain;
5. I will quickly leave the golf course at any time I am asked to do so by agents and/or employees of the golf course.
